



Ditching Cable to Start Streaming

What does cutting the cord mean?

- Pay less by eliminating cable and use one or multiple streaming sites.
- Use internet data to stream TV and Movies.

What Is Streaming?

- Streaming is media being sent over the internet and played in real time as it arrives. Content is never downloaded but instantly played.
- Content from streaming services is available on demand instantly and can be played an unlimited number of times.
- Content is sent from a streaming service (like Netflix) to a streaming player (like a Roku or Smart TV) which converts the data into video and sound.

What is needed to stream?

- Internet connection and a
- streaming device If you ditch cable, you still need to have internet data (it's no longer unlimited)
- What Data speeds are needed?

 - 20-100mbps and up, depends on Standard vs High Definition vs 4K
 Depends on number of users, quality of stream, device, user traffic



Terms to know

- Mirroring Showing your exact desktop, laptop, phone or tablet screen & movements, and projecting them via cable or wireless connection on a screen in the same room (such as a TV). The content will play on both devices.
- Free Trial—You will still need to put in credit card information, however the first X amount of days you will not be charged.
- Casting Playing online content (video, music, or other format, typically from a streaming service) on one device (such as a phone or laptop) to display on another device (such as a TV), usually by clicking a cast symbol. The content will display on the second device, and can be setup for any room.



Chromecast


- 3rd Gen Chromecast: \$35
 - Requires a smartphone or tablet to function (no remote)
- Chromecast Ultra: \$109 (4K/HDR)
- Google Chromecast w/Google TV: \$50
 - Combines most popular streaming services onto a single menu, less app jumping
 - Has voice remote with Google Assistant
 - Connects to HDMI port
- Project your android device screen through Chromecast
- Compatible with most streaming apps: Netflix, Hulu, Sling TV, etc.











Google TV gives suggestions based on all your apps.

Video Game Consoles







- Range between \$200-\$600
- Some also have Casting Capability like the Chromecast
- Most gaming consoles also allow for streaming on most available services



Smart TVs

- 4K- Sharper picture, vivid colors
- Smart TVs offer all the apps right through the TV
- Connects to Wifi
- You can browse the internet, access internet music channels, shop online, and more.
- 4K speeds cost more, need higher cost internet



Devices

- Download streaming apps to play on your device
- IOS through the Apple Store, Android through Google Play Store, or stream via an internet browser
- Watch when you travel, you just need internet
- Some services allow downloading for offline content












- Hulu is big on TV, but offers many movies as well as a selection of original content.















- Showtime, HBO Max, Cinemax, Starz





- Prime Video (without a Prime Membership) \$8.99/Month.
 - Roughly \$108/Year
- Prime Membership \$12.99/Month.
 - Prime Annual Roughly \$119/Year.
- 30 day free trial
- Amazon also offers a selection of newly released content as well as their own original content






 (Ad-supported) for \$13.99/mo or with Hulu (No Ads) for \$19.99/mo















CBSOALL ACCESS

- Paramount+ (Formerly CBS All Access) is a streaming service offering CBS Cable Programing as well as original content (inc. MTV, Nickelodeon, BET, Comedy Central, Sports HQ)
- It is \$5.99/mo with Ads and \$9.99/mo without
 - The ads option does not include current CBS shows





- Peacock Free stream some of Peacock content with Ads
- Peacock Premium- \$4.99/mo with ads, plus access to the bulk of the service's content
 - This includes live sports, original programing and next-day availability for current NBC shows
- Peacock Premium Plus- \$9.99/mo and mostly ad free (a select number of shows and movies will contain brief ads as well as programming that can be downloaded and viewed offline)
















- HBO Max is \$9.99/mo with Ads, for Ad free option \$14.99/mo




Free Apps

- CW- includes ads, typically keeps up to 5 new episodes for each show
- **PBS** Some episodes expire within a certain timeframe
- Pluto TV, Tubi, Crackle

Hoopla-

- All you need is your library card
 Add the app to Roku, Apple TV, Laptop, tablets or mobile devices
- No Ads
- **Includes Movies and TV**

Live TV





- Includes Cloud DVR
 - Store your recorded content online without the need for a physical DVR
 - Record multiple shows at once
- Many on-demand options Fast forward, pause and rewind DVR content for most
- Compatible with streaming devices No original content

- More channels = higher cost No contract, equipment, cancellation fees
- Many require a Home Network Limited 4K options

- 4K is extra for \$19.99/mo
- Unlimited storage, up to 3 screens
- Offers 85+ channels, including Network, News and Sports







Why Stream vs. Cable?

Pros

- Binge Watching- plenty of new and old shows
 Convenience- you can watch on your own
- timeframe
- Cost- cheaper than cable, devices are one time purchase
- Less physical equipment, installation, contracts and less negotiating rates (change or cancel plans easily)
- Less program interruptions
 Original TV and movie content
- Pořťable, multiple users

Cons

- Content can leave streaming service
 Lower cost versions have adds
- Variety of Apps and figuring out which service(s) to add, changing prices
